and lively spiritual conversation.



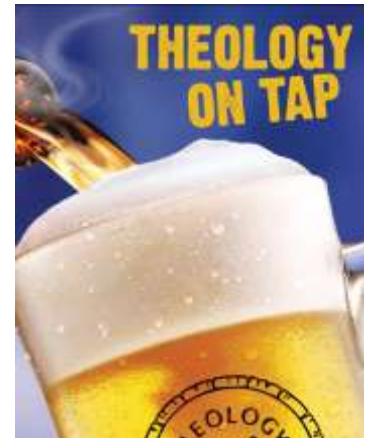
